The Trustees have pleasure in presenting their Annual Report together with audited financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2008.

OBJECTS

The principal activity of the charity as defined in its memorandum and articles of association is to promote the Christian religion in Wales or elsewhere according to the principals and usages of the free or independent churches. To alleviate need and distress among elderly ladies of British nationality irrespective of their religions denomination or political creed and to establish provide and manage homes for ladies in need or distress.

ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE

The charity is run by a Management Committee which meets regularly and employs a small team of staff who manage the organisation on a day to day basis.

REVIEW OF ACTIVITIES

The Charities area of operation is West Wales, the charity meets is objects by managing Bloomfield Eventide Home which is self funding. During the past year Bloomfield Eventide Home has continued to offer a high level of care for its residents. Occupancy rates have remained high which has allowed the Charity to be self funding. Ongoing maintenance and improvement works will the trustees believe continue to meet the charity objects.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The total income of £483,428 (2007 £569,058) was spent on direct charitable expenditure totalling £702,102 (2007 £546,130) and governance costs of £29,375 (2007 £3,211). This has resulted in net outgoing resources of £248,049 (2007 net incoming £19,717).

The statement of financial activities reflects the income and expenditure incurred by Bloomfield in carrying out its role in respect of its objectives. The general fund at 31 March 2008 was £428,365 (2007 £674,399), designated funds £4,198 (2007 £6,213).

The designated fund is in respect of a grant received to purchase fixed assets.

FIXED ASSETS

Details of changes in fixed assets are set out in Note 8 to the accounts.

INVESTMENT POLICY

The trustees have considered the most appropriate policy for investing funds. Money received from the sale of the land is placed on the money markets. The funds are placed for varying periods of time to obtain the greatest return. Funds could be made available for projects as required. The trustees regularly review the level of investments. At the year end no amounts were held in money market accounts.

RESERVE POLICY

It is the policy of the Trustees to ensure that the Charity has adequate reserves to enable it to meet both its ongoing commitments and its future funding requirements.

The Trustees accept that the current level of resources is not sufficient for the present situation and foreseeable requirements of the charity, and is currently in negotiations to improve its cash position.

RISK MANAGEMENT

The trustees actively review the major risks which the charity faces on a regular basis and believe that maintaining the free reserves at the levels stated above, combined with our annual review of the controls over key financial systems carried out through an internal audit programme, will provide sufficient resources in the event of adverse conditions. The trustees have also examined other operational and business risks which we face and confirm that they have established systems to mitigate the significant risks.

It also includes an assessment of the significant estimates and judgements made by the trustees in the preparation of the financial statements and of whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the charitable company's circumstances, consistently applied and adequately disclosed.

We planned and performed our audit so as to obtain all the information and explanations which we considered necessary in order to provide us with sufficient evidence to give reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatement, whether caused by fraud or error or other irregularity or error. However, poor books and records have been maintained and with respect to cash expenditure the evidence available to us was limited because there were no records kept.

In forming our opinion we also evaluated the overall adequacy of the presentation of information in the financial statements.

LIMITATION OF SCOPE: LACK OF CONTROLS OVER CASH RECORDS

Except for the financial effects of such adjustments, if any, as might have been determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves over the cash takings and expenditure, in our opinion the financial statements:-

- give a true and fair view, in accordance with United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice, of the state of the company's affairs as at 31 March 2008 and of its deficit for the year then ended; and
- have been properly prepared in accordance with the Companies Act 1985.

In respect solely of the limitation on our work relating to records of cash takings and expenditure:

- we have not obtained all the information and explanations that we considered necessary for the purpose of the audit; and
- we were unable to determine whether proper accounting records had been maintained.

In our opinion the information given in the Directors'-Report is consistent with the financial statements.

The company incurred a net loss of £248,049 during the year ended 31 March 2008 and, at that date, the company's current liabilities exceeded it current assets by £73,174. These conditions, along with other matters explained in note 17 to the financial statements, indicate the existence of a material uncertainty which may cast significant doubt about the company's ability to continue as a going concern. The financial statements do not include the adjustments that would result if the company was unable to continue as a going concern.
