

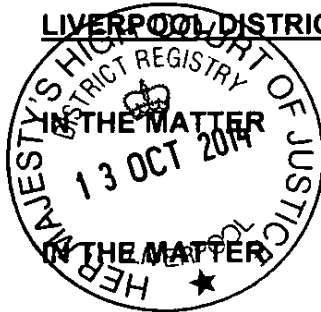

UPON THE APPLICATION by a Claim Form dated the 15<sup>th</sup> July 2014  
of Robert Adey the Claimant and a creditor of the above named South Dock  
'Ironworks Company Limited (hereinafter called "the Company")

AND UPON READING the evidence

AND IT APPEARING that there is no opposition on behalf of Her Majesty to  
the relief sought by this Claim as appears from the Evidence of Service of Stephen  
Watling and the exhibit thereto

AND on leave being given to amend the Claim Form to reflect the correct  
name of the Company as South Dock Ironworks Company Limited and re-service  
being dispensed with

AND the Claimant by his solicitors undertaking to

- (A) inform the Registrar of Companies of the title and Court reference  
number of the proposed litigation referred to in paragraph 4 of the  
Witness Statement of Stephen Watling dated the 4<sup>th</sup> July 2014  
immediately after issue

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- (B) inform the Registrar of Companies immediately on the conclusion of the said proposed litigation or any appeal therefrom or the conclusion of the claim by any other means
- (C) unless the said proposed litigation is completed in the interim, at 6 monthly intervals from the date of the order serve on the Registrar of Companies a full and sufficient Witness Statement setting out what steps have been taken to progress the said proposed litigation

AND UPON the solicitors for the Claimant and for the Registrar of Companies (the Defendant) both consenting to this Order

IT IS ORDERED THAT

- (1) the name of the above named South Dock Ironworks Company Limited be restored to the Register of Companies
- (2) the Company do continue in Compulsory Liquidation
- (3) if at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 01046373 Limited

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- (4) an Office Copy of the Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the Company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off
- (5) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in his official name in the "London Gazette"
- (6) in the event that the Claimant fail to comply with undertaking (C) above the Registrar of Companies be at liberty to commence strike off action in respect of the Company without further notice to the Claimant
