#### PRELIMINARY

- 1. The Regulations contained in Table A of The Companies (Tables A to F) Regulations 1985 (referred to in these articles as Table A") shall apply to the Company except to the extent that they are excluded or amended by the following clauses, which clauses together with the remaining clauses in Table A whall be the regulations of the Company.

Clause 8 in Table A shall be modified accordingly.

#### SHARES

- 4. The shares shall be under the control of the Directors and the Directors may allot, grant options over, or otherwise field with or dispose of any relevant securities (as defined by Section 80(2) of the Companies Act 1985) of the Company to such persons and generally on such terms and in such manner as they Whick Mis-


