3 Summary of Administrators' proposals

- 3.1 The objective of the Administration, as set out in the Administrators' proposals dated 29 January 2010, was to achieve a better result for the Company's creditors as a whole than would be likely if the Company were wound up or realise the assets for the benefit of secured and preferential creditors
- 3 2 My strategy for achieving this objective was to mange the business of the Company for as long as I believed it appropriate in attempting a more advantageous realisation of assets

4 Report and outcome

- 4.1 You will recall from my progress report dated 18 June 2010 that the only outstanding matter related to the agreement of my firm's fees and the closure of the Administration
- 4.2 The secured creditors gave their approval to the Administrators' remuneration and this has been taken as detailed below

5 Administrators' remuneration and disbursements

- In accordance with Statement of Insolvency Practice (SIP 9), I attach as Appendix II a summary of my firm's time costs to 3 December 2010 by grade of staff and type of work. This shows total time costs of £15,813 70 representing 64 73 hours at an average of £244 30 per hour, against which my firm has drawn fees of £8,296 on account. Details of any matters which have had a significant impact on the time costs are included in the appendix, together with details of any disbursements charged during the period under review.
