#### **NOTES**

- Joan Serrell has taken over Regalia from her daughter Claire now that Claire has switched her allegence from a Mini to a Hillman Imp!
- The club's exhibition stands are written off over five years and are now fully depreciated but the committee recently approved the purchase of some new exhibition equipment as the original stands have started to look tatty.
- The payment in advance represents insurance prepaid to February 2016
- 4 No Corporation Tax is payable as the total interest received was less than £500 below which the Revenue normally waive Corporation tax. The club has been advised that no tax is due on the surplus of subscription income as the surplus is a result of mutual trading.
- 5 Authorised Share Capital 100 Shares of £1 each

- 30% of subscriptions are now received by Paypal. The club didn't offer a Paypal facility until April 2013.
- The reason magazine production is higher than normal is because there was an underprovision of £400 in last year's accounts so last year's surplus was overstated by £400 and this year is understated by £400.

### **Treasurer's Report**

The accounts for the year ended 5th April 2015 show a surplus of £68 compared to £898 in the preceeding year as there was a £400 underprovision of magazine costs in 2014. In reality magazine production costs have remained almost constant despite the decision to introduce full colour printing.

Although the club has nearly £12,000 in cash the return on bank deposit accounts continues to be derisory at 0.05% while interest rates remain at a 300 year all time low. I recommend the club considers placing its surplus funds in a building society account designated for limited companies where it can earn a more generous 1.2%.

To celebrate the 50th anniversary of the launch of the Austin 1800 there was a major push to get 50 cars to attend the National Rally combined with BLMC day held at Gaydon on July 6th 2014. The final tally was 52 cars including two Austin 3 Litres and it was most impressive to see so many Landcrabs in attendance. There was a surprising variety of obscure BLMC vehicles on display including a brace of Australian P76's and an Innocenti variant of the Mini Metro

The End of Season **BLMC Rally was** held at Milton Keynes on 28th September 2015 attracting a good turnout of 12 Maxi's and 8 Landcrabs. This event is starting to become a major attraction on the BMC and BL calender featuring Allegros, TR7's, Metro's, Marina's and three SD1's with a surprise guest appearance from retired BLMC stylist Harris Mann.



A classic car display takes place on the second Sunday of every month in Queens Square, Bristol and features a wide range of pre and post war cars. If the weather is good then the whole square can be occupied by a wide variety of interesting cars ranging from Maxi's, Landcrabs, Mclaren's, an Edsel, De Lorean to a Marina Estate although I've yet to see any 1100's show up.
