UPON THE APPLICATION by a Claim Form dated the of Roy Hambidge the Claimant and a member and director of the above named RBH Services Limited (hereinafter called "the Company")

AND UPON READING the evidence

AND IT APPEARING that there is no opposition on behalf of Her Majesty to the relief sought by this Claim as appears from the Evidence of Service of Steven Cameron Carrigan and the exhibit thereto

AND the Claimant undertaking that:

(A) the company will not carry on business or operate in any way other than to take the necessary steps to (i) pursue the proposed litigation seeking the recovery of monies owed by David Jordan pursuant to an agreement, referred to in paragraph 1 of the Second Witness Statement of Steven Cameron Carrigan dated the 7th November 2016 (ii) receive an award from the Court if successful in the said proposed litigation (iii) settle all outstanding debts to its existing creditors, if any; and (iv) distribute the remaining balance of any monies awarded by the Court (the actions) according to law.

- (B) he will notify the Registrar of Companies of the title and Court reference of the said proposed litigation immediately after issue.
- (C) he will inform the Registrar of Companies immediately on the conclusion of the said proposed litigation or any appeal therefrom or the conclusion of the claim by any other means.
- (D) a director of the company will immediately on the expiry of 3 months from the conclusion of the actions apply to the Registrar of Companies for the voluntary strike off of the company under Section 1003 of the Companies Act 2006 and comply with all the relevant requirements for such an application.

AND UPON the solicitors for the Claimant and the Registrar of Companies (the Defendant) both consenting to this Order

IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) the name of the above named RBH Services Limited be restored to the Register of Companies
- (2) if at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 04959225 Limited

- (3) an Office Copy of this Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off
- (4) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in his official name in the "London Gazette"
