

Chairman's Report for the Year ended 31.3.2016

The South London Resource Centre for Visually Impaired People (SLRC) continues to provide the administrative framework for the Hospital Low Vision Service for Guy's and St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust. SLRC engages the sessional optometrists and co-ordinates attendance of the volunteers who make the patient appointments, provide technical support, distribute the low vision aids and ensure that patient records are properly maintained. Whilst the Charity has no employed staff, it provides payments to individuals for various services, including presentations to the Wednesday Club, the programme of talks and discussions designed to help patients come to terms with loss of vision, and for the musical direction of the VIP Singers who now meet for rehearsal each Monday at St Thomas' and give regular performances at local events.

The Southwark Outreach Clinic is held on the first Friday in each month to ease the demands on the main Hospital Low Vision clinic and provide local users with a more convenient venue. It is planned to extend this facility into Lambeth once a suitable location has been secured.

SLRC's ninth annual Low Vision Day was held at St Thomas' Hospital of Saturday 24th October 2015, with a large number of Charities and Visual Aids suppliers being represented. Visitors had the opportunity to try "blind tennis", martial arts and guided cycling along the Thames Embankment. Undergraduate optometry students from City University are welcomed as sighted guides and helpers throughout the day

The aim of the Charity remains to work with Guys and St Thomas' NHS Trust, with Local Authorities' Sensory Assessment Teams and with the various service providers within the South London Boroughs, to improve the overall support available to those most in need.
