#### LIQUIDATOR'S ACTIONS SINCE LAST REPORT

Since my last annual progress report, I have been in correspondence with the Revenue to obtain tax clearance.

I have now obtained written correspondence from the Revenue that they have no tax matters outstanding and the Revenue have granted clearance in respect of Corporation Tax, PAYE and VAT.

There is certain work that I am required by the insolvency legislation to undertake work in connection with the liquidation that provides no financial benefit for the creditors. A description of the routine work undertaken since my last progress report is as follows:-

#### 1. Administration

- Case planning devising an appropriate strategy for dealing with the case and giving instructions to the staff to undertake the work on the case.
