

- BASE GREEN GIBSON'S YARD LIMITED incorporated and registered in England (1) and Wales with company number 09015806 whose registered office is at c/o Hazlems Fenton LLP, Palladium House, 1-4 Argyll Street, London W1F 7LD (Borrower)

BACKGROUND

- The Lender has agreed, under the Facility Agreement, to provide the Borrower with (A) loan facilities on a secured basis
- The Borrower owns the Property (B)
- Under this deed, the Borrower provides security to the Lender for all its present and (C) future obligations and liabilities to the Lender under the Facility Agreement and for any further or additional loan facilities made to the Borrower in the future pursuant to the Facility Agreement as amended, supplemented or restated from time to time

The Borrower's liability under this deed in respect of any of the Secured Liabilities shall not be discharged, prejudiced or affected by

5 2 Immediate recourse

The Borrower is the legal and beneficial owner of the Charged Property and has good and marketable title to the Property

The Charged Property is free from any Security other than the Security created by this deed or subject to the Deed of Priority

The Borrower has not received, or acknowledged notice of, any adverse claim by any person in respect of the Charged Property or any interest in it

This deed constitutes and will constitute the legal, valid, binding and enforceable obligations of the Borrower (subject to usual qualifications at law or equity relating to rights and remedies of creditors on insolvency or

otherwise) and is and will continue to be effective security over all and every part of the Charged Property in accordance with its terms

The Borrower shall permit the Lender and any Receiver and any person appointed by either of them to enter on and inspect the Property on reasonable prior notice

8 18 VAT option to tax

The Borrower shall not, without the prior written consent of the Lender revoke any VAT option to tax exercised, and disclosed to the Lender in writing, before the date of this deed

9. Powers of the Lender

9 1 Power to remedy

- 911 The Lender shall be entitled (but shall not be obliged) to remedy, at any time, a breach by the Borrower of any of its obligations contained in this deed
- 912 The Borrower irrevocably authorises the Lender and its agents to do all things that are necessary or desirable for that purpose

13 13 **Bring proceedings**

A Receiver may bring, prosecute, enforce, defend and abandon all actions, suits and proceedings in relation to any of the Charged Property that he thinks fit

13 14 Insure

A Receiver may, if he thinks fit, but without prejudice to the indemnity in clause 16.2, effect with any insurer any policy of insurance either in lieu or satisfaction of, or in addition to, the insurance required to be maintained by the Borrower under this deed

13 15 Powers under LPA 1925

If the liabilities to be set off are expressed in different currencies, the Lender may convert either liability at a market rate of exchange for the purpose of set-off. 21 2 No obligation to set off

No amendment of this deed shall be effective unless it is in writing and signed by, or on behalf of, each party (or its authorised representative)

22 2 Waivers and consents

- 22 2 1 A waiver of any right or remedy under this deed or by law, or any consent given under this deed, is only effective if given in writing by the waiving or consenting party and shall not be deemed a waiver of any other breach or default. 23. Severance

If any provision (or part of a provision) of this deed is or becomes invalid, illegal or unenforceable, it shall be deemed modified to the minimum extent necessary to make it valid, legal and enforceable. If such modification is not possible, the relevant provision (or part of a provision) shall be deemed deleted. Any modification to or deletion of a provision (or part of a provision) under this clause shall not affect the legality, validity and enforceability of the rest of this deed

24. Counterparts

- 24 2 Transmission of the executed signature page of a counterpart of this deed by fax or e-mail (in PDF, JPEG or other agreed format) shall take effect as delivery of an executed counterpart of this deed if either method of delivery is adopted, without prejudice to the validity of the deed thus made. each party shall provide the others with the original of such counterpart as soon as reasonably possible thereafter
- 243 No counterpart shall be effective until each party has executed and delivered at least one counterpart

25. Third party rights

- 25 1 Except as expressly provided elsewhere in this deed, a person who is not a party to this deed shall not have any rights under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 to enforce, or enjoy the benefit of, any term of this deed. This does not affect any right or remedy of a third party which exists, or is available, apart from that Act
- 25 2 The rights of the parties to rescind or agree any amendment or waiver under this deed are not subject to the consent of any other person

26. **Further provisions**

26 1 Independent security

The security constituted by this deed shall be in addition to, and independent of, any other security or guarantee that the Lender may hold for any of the Secured Liabilities at any time. No prior security held by the Lender over the whole or any part of the Charged Property shall merge in the security created by this deed

26 2 **Continuing security**

The security constituted by this deed shall remain in full force and effect as a continuing security for the Secured Liabilities, despite any settlement of account, or intermediate payment, or other matter or thing, unless and until the Lender discharges this deed in writing

26 3 Discharge conditional

Any release, discharge or settlement between the Borrower and the Lender shall be deemed conditional on no payment or security received by the Lender in respect of the Secured Liabilities being avoided, reduced or ordered to be refunded under any law relating to insolvency, bankruptcy, winding-up, administration, receivership or otherwise. - 26 3 2 the Lender may recover the value or amount of such security or payment from the Borrower subsequently as if the release, discharge or settlement had not occurred

26 4 Certificates

A certificate or determination by the Lender as to any amount for the time being due to it from the Borrower under this deed and the Facility Agreement shall be, in the absence of any manifest error, conclusive evidence of the amount due

26 5 Consolidation

The restriction on the right of consolidation contained in section 93 of the LPA 1925 shall not apply to this deed
