1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The company is reliant upon support from the director who has indicated that she is willing to continue support for the foreseeable future. Accordingly the director feels that the going concern basis of preparation is appropriate.

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015).

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods, excluding value added tax.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery etc - 25% on reducing balance

Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Going concern

In preparing the accounts and reviewing the company's net current liability position of £234,994 (2015:£217,324), the director has considered going concern and that the company will continue to trade for the foreseeable future.
