DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Daniel's Dens motto is TEAM - Together Everyone Achieves More and this was truly lived out throughout the year

In the autumn term we celebrated 10 years of Daniel's Den During our 'ten days to celebrate ten years' programme we had various activities including a meal to thank all our volunteers, a thanksgiving service at the local church, special visitors including Pete Broadbent the Bishop of Willesden and Baroness Amos (the Leader of the House of Lords) and finally a large birthday party when all the children, parents and carers from the past ten years were invited to share in the celebrations. A special 10th Anniversary Book was published to mark this milestone and every family was presented with one of these and a special anniversary mug

New families continue to join us. Everyone who comes along comments upon the friendly family atmosphere and it is wonderful to see children settling in, learning to play and share with their new friends. Parents/carers too make new friendships and learn lots about parenting! One mum commented that she feels so uplifted just by walking in the room. Our main form of advertising is through word of mouth but the internet is proving to be a key advertising tool and our website serves an excellent purpose in keeping people informed about our meeting times, activities etc.

We continue to organise events to bring the whole family together in fun ways. As well as out tenth anniversary celebrations we also had Dad's Zone, nativity plays, termly lunch events for over 60's, a healthy eating week, sports week and a teddy bears picnic with presentation of certificates to those leaving to go to nursery or reception classes. We ran a parenting course February to May 2007 and one of the mums reported that her son's school had commented on the improvement in his behaviour and attitude - she said this can be attributed to her attending the course.

We continue to build links with other toddler groups and a team from Daniel's Den spent a week in the Isle of Man encouraging the parent and toddler groups there as well as other parts of the UK We also set up a support group for parent and toddler group leaders in Brent and this now meets termly. We have also built links with national organisations that work with children and families and have led seminars at their conferences in Eastbourne and Tunbridge Wells

We are in the third year of our 5 year vision plan and it is encouraging to see how the targets we have set are being met and indeed surpassed. This is reviewed annually at our business-planning weekend. We are delighted that we have two new members on our management team — Petra Daley and Rosalind Wilson. Both bring essential skills to the team. We took part in a 6 month quality assurance programme PQASSO and were successful in completing level one. We also ran training for our volunteers.

NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 AUGUST 2007

1 Accounting Policies

1.1 Basis of preparation

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice, "Accounting and Reporting by Charities" and applicable legislations

1.2 Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included in the Statement of Financial Activities when the organisation is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy

1.3 Resource Expended

All expenditure is accounted for on an accrual basis and has been included under expenses categories that aggregate all costs for allocation to activities. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular activities they have been allocated on a basis consistent with the use of the resources.

Administrative expenditure relates to costs incurred in running and managing the organisation

1.4 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

The company has no fixed assets

1.5 Share Capital

The company is limited by guarantee and does not issue shares

1.6 Funds

General funds are unrestricted funds which are available for use at the discretion of of the directors in furtherance of the general objectives of the organisation and which have not been designated for other purposes

Restricted funds are those funds which are to be used in accordance with specific restrictions imposed by donors which have been raised by the organisation for particular purposes. The cost of raising and administering such funds are charged against the specific fund.
