2. Joint liquidators' actions since the last report

- 2.1. This report should be read in conjunction with my previous progress reports and my receipts and payments account, which is attached as Appendix 1. Please note that the figures are shown net of VAT.
- 2.2. As previously reported, I have identified various matters of potential concern regarding the Company and associated group companies Winlen Bay Limited, Denny Price Agencies Limited and DXT Limited. I would refer creditors to my previous progress reports for further details relating to the nature and type of my enquiries and the complexity of the matters under consideration, primarily due to the extensive level of intercompany trading.
- 2.3. My investigations remain ongoing and I am continuing to take the advice of my solicitors, KW Law LLP, as regards the progression of the claims. So as not to prejudice the claims, I am unable to divulge within this report any further specific details regarding the claims or the progress of my investigations. However, I can disclose that I am intending to mediate with the respondents in respect of the claims in late 2017 or early 2018. I hope to have positive news to report to creditors thereafter.
- 2.4. In addition to dealing with the realisation of assets, I have to meet various legislative and best practice requirements and deadlines. These matters include filing of documents with the Registrar of Companies, ensuring that all receipts and payments are dealt with in a timely basis and proper accounting records are maintained, undertaking periodic case progression reviews, advising creditors of the liquidation and recording all claims received, together with other day to day matters that arise.

3. Dividend prospects

3.1. Preferential creditors:

No preferential claims were anticipated and none have been received to date.

3.2. Floating charge creditor and the prescribed part:

- As there is a floating charge over the assets of the Company, the prescribed part provisions apply. The floating charge was granted to Mr Ron Coulson on 17 January 2011 and covers a total of £206,000 advanced to the Company.
- I declared and paid an interim dividend of £100,000 to the floating charge holder on 28 August 2012.
- A further distribution to the floating charge creditor remains a possibility but at present the timing and quantum is uncertain.

3.3. Unsecured creditors:

- Whilst I have received a various claims from unsecured creditors, I have not incurred the costs of formally agreeing all claims until final dividend prospects are certain.
- To date, claims received from creditors totalling £703,942.49 have been received and I have been satisfied to agree and admit for dividend purposes claims totalling £579,362.38. The remainder are held over pending further enquiries or clarification. In addition, various creditors have not yet submitted claims.
- As noted above, when I declared the interim dividend to the floating charge holder, I calculated the prescribed part funds available to unsecured creditors to be £40,494.40 on the basis of the projected final position at that time. Based on the dividend to the floating charge holder being £100,000.00, the prescribed parts funds due to unsecured creditors are £28,750.00.

4. Pre-appointment remuneration

4.1 The costs and expenses incurred by BRI Business Recovery and Insolvency in respect of the preparation of the statement of affairs and convening the meeting of creditors have, in accordance with the resolution passed at the meeting of creditors, been paid out of the assets of the liquidation. These pre-appointment time costs amounted to £7,500.00 plus VAT.

5. Joint liquidators' remuneration

- 5.1. My remuneration was previously authorised by creditors at a meeting held on 8 September 2011 to be drawn on a time costs basis. My total time costs to 7 September 2017 amount to £99,394.75, which consists of 617.70 hours at an average charge out rate of £160.91. £12,334.00 of this was charged in the period between 8 September 2016 and 7 September 2017, which consists of 61.10 hours at an average charge out rate of £201.87. I have drawn remuneration totalling £98,700.00 plus VAT to 7 September 2017, of which £12,200.00 plus VAT was drawn in the period subsequent to my last annual progress report. Schedules of my time costs incurred to date are attached as Appendices 2 and 3.
- 5.2. For the benefit of creditors, the Association of Business and Recovery Professionals publish 'A Creditors' Guide to Liquidators' Fees'. This document is available by visiting www.briuk.co.uk and clicking on the 'Creditors' Guide to Fees' option on the headings bar. Please note that there are different versions for cases that commenced before or after 6 April 2010 and in this case you should refer to the post-April 2010 version. A hard copy of this document can be obtained on request from any of our offices.

6. Joint liquidators' expenses

6.1. Details of the expenses that I have paid are shown on the attached receipts and payments account and are

largely self-explanatory.

6.2. The following expenses have been incurred but have not yet been paid:-

6.3. My choice of professionals was based on my knowledge of their experience and ability to perform the type of work required. I have reviewed the fees charged and I am satisfied that they are reasonable in the circumstances of this case.

7. Further information

- 7.1. An unsecured creditor may, with the permission of the court or with the concurrence of 5% in value of the unsecured creditors (including the creditor in question), request further details of the joint liquidators' remuneration and expenses, within 21 days of receipt of this report. Any secured creditor may request the same details in the same time limit.
- 7.2. An unsecured creditor may, with the permission of the court or with the concurrence of 10% in value of the creditors (including the creditor in question), apply to court to challenge the amount and/or basis of the joint liquidators' fees and the amount of any proposed expenses or expenses already incurred, within 8 weeks of receipt of this report. Any secured creditor may make a similar application to court within the same time limit.

8. Conclusion

- 8.1. The liquidation will remain open until I have able to fully conclude my investigations and the various associated claims. I am unable to give any firm indication of when that might be at present but I would hope that the aforementioned mediation is successful in bringing matters to a close.
