For the year ended 31st December 1981

In submitting this Report and statement of accounts for the ended 31st December 1981, in accordance with the rules and constitution of the Rhondda Golf Club, I would like to express my sincere thanks to all members for making my year as Captain, a very enjoyable and worthwhile experience.

Unfortunately, we are unable to report any satisfactorty conclusion to date in resolving our differences associated with our Landlord.
