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TRUSTEES' REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 AUGUST 2013

The Trustees of the Chanty present their Annual Report and the financial statements for the year ended 31 August 2013

Objects of the Charity

Deserving Children Africa is a small Christian charity which was established in 2011 to provide a meal a day for some of the most destitute children in Nakeel Primary School in Nairobi, Kenya

Developments during the period

Child Feeding Programme

A feeding programme was set up to provide one meal a day to children at Nakeel Primary School at a cost of £3 00 per child for a month

The head teacher has identified 500 pupils aged between 5 and 13 years who are in need of assistance. Currently 91 children are receiving sponsorship through the charity

School Fees Programme

The charity aims to sponsor older children to go on to higher education after they leave the school at 13 So far we have been able to sponsor one child on the programme

Fundraising and Events

The chanty has organised a number of fundraising events during the year including a book sale and the sale of cream teas at Stoke Poges fete. They have also established links with St Andrew's and St Giles' Church in Stoke Poges and St Paul's Church in Slough

Organisation

Deserving Children Africa was incorporated as a company limited by guarantee on 19 August 2010 It was established as a registered charity on 31 December 2013

The Trustees who served during the year ended 31 August 2013, who are also directors for the purpose of Company law, are listed in the Information section on page 2. None has any beneficial interest in the Company, all are members and each one guarantees to contribute £10 in the event of a winding up.

TRUSTEES' REPORT CONTINUED FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 AUGUST 2013

Financial review

This is the first full year of operation of the chanty

Child sponsorship income was £1,034 and school fees income was £360

Fundraising activities amounted to £1,134 and a donation of £3,100 was received during the year

Charitable activities expended £1,580 during the year including administrative costs of £130

At the year end, total funds amounted to £4,106

Plans for the future

There is a limited number of children that can be fed under the current feeding programme. The trustees would like to purchase a plot of land close to Nakeel Primary School that would enable the charity to establish its own feeding centre in the future.

The trustees are planning several fundraising events for 2014 and are reviewing other ways of generating funds for the charity
