Report of the Directors For the Year ended 31st March 2003

The Directors present their Annual report of the Company for the year ended 31st March 2003.

Principal Activity

The principal activity of the Company in the year under review was to advance the Christian Religion particularly among the Asian community within Wolverhampton and elsewhere including the provision of regular bi-lingual forms of worship.

The Company is limited by guarantee and is a charity registered with the Charity Commissioners number 1077661 and is not, therefore, subject to Corporation Tax.

Directors Responsibilities

Company Law requires the Directors to prepare Accounts for each financial year, which give true and fair view of the state of affairs of the Company and of the profit or loss of the company for that period. In preparing those accounts, the Directors are required to:

Select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently.

Make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent.

Follow applicable accounting standards, subject to any material departures disclosed and explained in the Accounts.

Prepare the Accounts on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the Company will continue in business.

The Directors are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the company and enable them to ensure that the accounts comply with the Companies Act 1985. They are also responsible for the safeguarding the assets of the Company and hence for taking of reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

Review of Activities

This has been a successful year for AEC, with regular Sunday worship, bible study and prayer meetings. The numbers attending have increased, and in particular, we have attracted more young people to become involved in Church activities.

The Church has benefited from a generous donation of £50,000 from Bilston Resource Centre, which uses the premises during the week to provide information, advice & guidance, and training in IT and Basic Skills. The reserves have increased to £87,922, and the Directors have agreed to place £50,000 of this into a Building Reserve to meet the costs of acquiring the premises at St. Michaels Mission Hall, and for extending and improving the facilities.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards and follow the recommendations in Statement of Recommended Practice: Accounting for Charities (SORP) issued in October 2000.

Intangible income is valued and included in income to the extent that it represents goods or services where another party is bearing the financial cost and the benefit is quantifiable. Where it is difficult or not possible to quantify the benefit, or where there is no financial cost borne by another party (eg, volunteers), the accounts do not include the intangible income.

Intangible income is valued and included in income to the extent that it represents goods or services which would otherwise be purchased. Where it is difficult or not possible to value the goods or services, such as volunteer time, the accounts do not include them.

Grants, including grants for the purchase of fixed assets, are recognised in full in the Statement of Financial Activities in the year in which they are received.

Restricted funds are to be used for specified purposes as required by the donor. Expenditure which meets these criteria is allocated to the relevant fund. Income derived from these funds is retained within the funds concerned. Designated funds are unrestricted funds which the trustees have designated to be used for a specific purpose. Where these funds yield investment income, this is available for general purposes. Unrestricted funds are funds which are not designated or restricted.

Depreciation is calculated at a rate to write off the cost of tangible fixed assets on a Reducing Balance over their estimated useful lives. The rates applied per annum are as follows:
