Plant and machinery 20% reducing balance

Fixtures and fittings 20% reducing balance

Deferred tax assets are provided to the extent they may be recoverable. Deferred taxation is calculated on an un-discounted basis at the tax rates which are expected to apply in the periods when the timing differences will reverse.
