1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES**1.1 Basis of preparation of financial statements**

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and include the results of the company's operations which are described in the Director's Report.

The company has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard No.1 from the requirement to produce a cash flow statement on the grounds that it is a small company.

1.2 Turnover

Turnover comprises the invoiced value of goods and services supplied by the company, exclusive of Value Added Tax .

1.3 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation
