NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2001

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

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a) Basis of accounting

The Company prepares its accounts in accordance with the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Statement for Smaller Entities (effective March 2000).

b) Companies Act requirements

The Directors are of the opinion that, as the Company is a non-trading organisation, the accounts formats prescribed by the Companies Acts are inappropriate. These accounts, therefore, are presented in a form which, in the Directors' opinion, better gives a true and fair view of the Company's affairs.

c) Freehold Property

The company acquired the freehold of Ashbourne Court in August 1997 at a cost of £14,773 and, at or about the same time, agreed in principle to vary the provisions of all flat leases by the extension of their individual terms and the substitution of a nominal or peppercorn rent in place of the specified ground rent. The costs of purchase were met by the lessees personally and the freehold interest has no commercial value. Accordingly no value is attributed to it herein.
