DIRECTORS' ANNUAL REPORT (For the year ending 30th June 1999)

This year the Company continued to bring high-quality international works for the theatre to audiences in Britain and to organise public debate on the issues raised in these productions. The Company also commissioned two translations and presented two readings and a performance event in venues other than theatres, thus stimulating and encouraging new audiences.

The season opened with the Halloween Masquerade - a performance event featuring musicians, stilt walkers and puppeteers.

A new translation of 'Turcaret' by Rene Lesage was commissioned from Ann Bernardi for readings in the 287 Restaurant and at the Candid Arts Trust Islington. The Company also organised a reading of 'Canticle' by John Mackendrick, based on the life of the renaissance composer Carlo Maria Gesualdo, in the Chapel of St. Barnabus, Soho.

The Arts Council of England and the SACD in France awarded funding for the translation commissioned from David Z. Mairowitz of 'La Reine d'Arles' by Annie Corbier. The Riverside Studios agreed to present the production in September/October, subject to funding. Nikos Dionysios was appointed as director. It was decided to present two exhibitions of painting, sculpture and artefacts from artists working in the Provence area of France at the same time as the production and to establish an educational programme based on the culture and language of this area. An application was sent to the EEC funding scheme, Kaleidoscope. Application was also made for funds from the Season of French Plays and the French Embassy as well as the LAB. Mme. Liliane Bonfils of the artists association Courants d'Arts in Nimes agreed to organise an exhibition and applied for funding from the CAA and municipal sources. This exhibition would take place at the Spitz Gallery, Spitalfields. The other exhibition would be curated by Dr.Jacques Aldebert, president of The International Contemporary Arts Association and Forza Arte, and presented at the Clink Wharf Gallery, on the South Bank.

The Spring tour of 'You Are My Mother', which received funding from the Tudor Charitable Trust and The Snipe Trust, was so well received that it was decided to attempt to raise funding for another tour in the Spring of 2000.

The Company registered for VAT.

Mrs. P.A. Jones agreed to increase the loan to the Company by £1,675 and that the Company should not commence any repayments of her loan until such time as the Company's profits enabled it to do so.

It was decided that in the next season the Company should continue with a programme of readings as well as presenting the world premiere of 'The Queen of Arles' and organising

another tour of 'You Are My Mother'.
