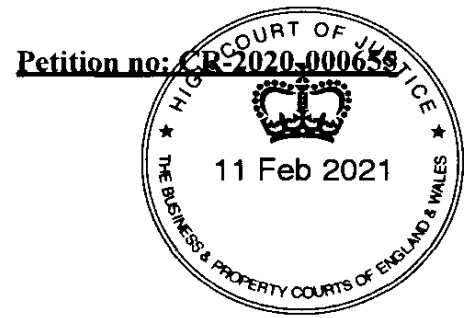

ORDER

BEFORE INSOLVENCY AND COMPANIES COURT JUDGE PRENTIS

**HAVING REGARD to the winding up Order of Insolvency and Companies Court
Judge Barber dated 16th December 2020**

AND UPON the application of Stuart Bayliss dated 23rd December 2020

**AND UPON hearing by Microsoft Teams Justina Stewart counsel for the First
Respondent, Karen Field for the Second Respondent and Jean Rossi solicitor for the
Applicant**

**AND UPON the Court being satisfied that the said Order to wind up has been made in
error**

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The order winding-up Better Retirement Group Limited made by Insolvency and**

Companies Court Judge Barber on 16th December 2020 be rescinded.

2. The petition of The Commissioners For Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs issued on 29th January 2020, with court reference CR-2020-000655 be restored to the list with a return date of 24th March 2021.
3. The First Respondent's costs of this application, summarily assessed in the sum of £1,033.20, be paid by the Applicant by 4 PM on the 24th February 2021.
4. The Second Respondent's costs, in the sum of £1,600.00, be borne by the Applicant, said costs having already been paid by the transfer of £11,000.00 by the Applicant, with any surplus to be refunded to the Applicant.
5. The Registrar of Companies do remove the said Order to wind up the Company from the records of the Company kept by them and place in such records a note that the Order to wind up the Company was made in error and rescinded by Order of this Court.
