Structure, governance and management

The Trust is a company limited by guarantee and is governed by its Memorandum and Articles of Association dated 24 April 2006 and subsequently amended by a special resolution dated 2 December 2006

The trustees have assessed the major risks to which the Trust is exposed, and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate exposure to the major risks

Objectives and activities

The Trust's objects are

- 1 to promote and maintain the standards of the craft of horse logging for the public benefit, and
- 2 to advance education and training in the craft of horse logging and associated skills

The Trust's activities during the year were

- Submission of grant applications resulting in a commitment payable on demand of £9,000 from the Ernest Cook Trust and a commitment of £32,850 over the next two years from the Headley Trust to fund the second and third year of our planned apprenticeship scheme. Neither of these are included in income during this year as there was no certainty of entitlement at the year end date.
- With the help of a consultant, drafting of documentation to secure accreditation of the course as equivalent to NVQ level III and its submission to Open College of the North West, On 23 June 2008 the scheme was accredited by OCNW as a Level III qualification, without any conditions
- testing of the draft procedures through the selection of an apprentice who started training but chose not to continue so only £244 was paid as bursary. He was not at any time an employee of the Trust

Financial review

The total incoming resources for the year amounted to £335, of which £250 was donations received and £85 interest received. Total resources expended amounted to £1,277. As a result total reserves at the end of the financial year amounted to £4,328.

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 APRIL 2008

It is the policy of the Trust that unrestricted funds which have not been designated for a specific use should be maintained at a level, which is at least, equivalent to six month's expenditure. This level of reserves has been exceeded during the year. The Trust is still in the early stages of development. Annual expenditure levels moving forward are yet to be established and so the Trust is building reserve levels in anticipation of future activity. The chanty will review its reserves policy on an ongoing basis.

Plans for the future

During the forthcoming year, the charity are looking to recruit and start the training of a new apprentice to help with the desired expansion of the charity

They will also be looking for further funding opportunities to help aid future expansion
