

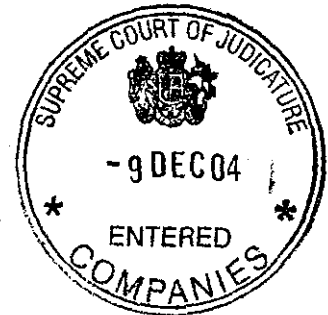

MINUTE OF ORDER

UPON THE PETITION of The Designer Room (Holdings) Limited (the **Company**) whose registered office is situated at Chiltern House, 24-30 King Street, Watford, Hertfordshire, WD18 0BP presented to the Court on 2 November 2004 by its Joint Administrators, Vivian Murray Bairstow and Nicholas Roy Hood (the **Applicants**) both of the firm Begbies Traynor.

AND UPON HEARING Counsel for the Applicants.

AND UPON READING the evidence.

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that these proceedings are main proceedings as defined in Article 3 of the EC Regulation.

IT IS ORDERED that

- 1 The Administration Order dated 12 June 2002 be discharged pursuant to Section 18 Insolvency Act 1986 (the **Act**).
- 2 The Applicants be released as Joint Administrators pursuant to section 20 of the Act 28 days after they have submitted the requisite accounts of the receipts and payments of the Company pursuant to rule 2.52(1) of the Insolvency Rules 1986.
- 3 The Company be wound up pursuant to the provisions of the Act.
- 4 The Applicants be appointed as joint liquidators of the Company, pursuant to section 140 of the Act.
- 5 The costs of and occasioned by the petition be treated as an expense of the administration.
