

Notes to the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2003

1. Accounting policies

1.1. Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost accounting rules.

The company has taken advantage of the exemption from preparing a cash flow statement conferred by Financial Reporting Standard No.1 on the grounds that it is entitled to the exemptions available in Sections 246 to 247 of the Companies Act 1985 for small companies.

1.2. Turnover

Turnover represents the amount derived from the provision of goods and sservices falling within the company's activities after deduction of trade discounts and value added tax.
