

- 2. The Company is to be a Public Company.
- The registered office of the Company will be situated in England and Wales.
- The objects for which the Company is established are-4.
 - To carry on in the United Kingdom, and elsewhere, the business of Fine Art Publishers, and Dealers in Works of Art, including therein the purchasing of copyrights, the purchase, hire, sale, and exhibition of pictures, drawings, engravings, photographs, sculpture, and other works of art.
 - To acquire by purchase or otherwise any messuage, rooms, gallery, or other premises for the objects herein named, or any of them, and to resell or underlet any part thereof.
 - To purchase the Fine Art publishing business of (3) Messrs. J. Dickinson & Co., carried on by them at 31 Ely Place, London, together with the goodwill, stock-in-trade, and copyrights in connection therewith.
 - To purchase or acquire from any person or persons, (4) society, or corporation, any business comprised in the objects of the Company, and the goodwill and connection, stock-in-trade, and effects, owned or used in connection therewith, or any interest therein, or part or share thereof respectively, and either for Shares or upon such terms as the Company deem fit.
