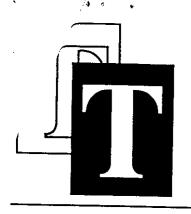

### (1) Form of Assistance

The assistance will be take the form of the execution of the following documents:-

- 1. A Companies Invoice Sale and Purchase Agreement (Undisclosed) with Alex Lawrie Receivables Financing Limited
- 2. A set of Standard Terms & Conditions in favour of Alex Lawrie Receivables Financing Limited
- 3. A Memorandum and Charge in favour of Alex Lawrie Receivables Financing Limited
- 4. A Facility Letter in favour of Midland Bank plc
- 5. A Debenture in favour of Midland Bank plc
- 6. A Deed of Unlimited Guarantee in favour of Midland Bank plc
- 7. A Loan Agreement with Cromalt Limited (being the person assisted)
- 8. A Bonus Agreement relating to the payment of a bonus by the Company to Mr. William Worrall (being one of the Vendors)
- (2) The principal terms on which the assistance will be given are:
- 2.1 The Company will enter into an invoice discounting arrangement with Alex Lawrie Receivables Financing Limited, pursuant to which the Company will sell and Alex Lawrie Receivables Financing Limited will purchase, the book debts of the Company and the proceeds of sale thereof. This transaction will be effected on the terms contained in the Invoice Sale and Purchase Agreement and the Standard Terms and Conditions and the Company's obligations will be secured by way of a Charge over the book debts and proceeds of realisation thereof of the Company.
- 2.2 The Company will obtain facilities from Midland Bank plc under the terms of a Facility Letter to be executed by the Company. Pursuant to the terms of the said Facility Letter, the Company will enter into a Deed of Unlimited Guarantee, whereby the Company undertakes to guarantee the obligations of Cromalt Limited (being the person assisted) towards Midland Bank plc. The obligations of the Company under the terms of its facility and in relation to the guarantee given in connection with the obligations of Cromalt Limited will be secured by a Debenture comprising a Fixed and Floating Charge over the property, assets and undertaking of the Company.
- 2.3 The Company will advance the sum of £76,300 realised in relation to the facilities being

- afforded by Alex Lawrie Receivables Financing Limited to Cromalt Limited on the date of completion of the acquisition of the share capital under the terms of the Loan Agreement, thereby enabling it to discharge its liability to make payment of the consideration for the shares due on the date of completion.
- 2.4 The Company will enter into a Bonus Agreement with Mr. William Worrall (being one of the parties disposing of his shares in the Company to the person being assisted), pursuant to which the Company will agree to pay a bonus to Mr. Worrall in recognition of his services as a director, such bonus being equivalent to the trading profits of the Company for the financial year ended 31st December 1997.
