## **Notes**

As the company has been set up to make it simpler to manage expenditure for website domain and paying for activities so that no tax is payable personally in addition to employment, there is no intention of the company to make a surplus. Any money that remains in the company accounts will be used to pay for managing the organisations communication such as website presence and take advantage of business rates for hall hire etc where possible.

During the first year, £200 was loaned to the company interest free in order that payments could be made for activities. Although website advertising is being considered for 2008/2009 there is a likelihood that this will not be paid back in the medium term (5 year period) and will be done only at a time when there are enough funds to pay for at least 5 years worth of website fees.
