NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE PERIOD ENDED 30 DECEMBER 2013

1. **ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

1.1 Basis of preparation of financial statements

The full financial statements, from which these abbreviated accounts have been extracted, have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

1.2 Going concern

These financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis, notwithstanding the fact that the company had a net deficit of £2,767,140 at the balance sheet date.

Due to interest charges being incurred the directors had expected to operate at a loss for the medium term following incorporation. The company's operations have required significant levels of borrowing and related interest to fund the construction of a property that has been subsequently leased to a third party. This project is performing as expected, the company has returned to profit before tax during the current period and financial projections for the company also indicate that growing profits will be generated in future years.

The company meets its day to day working capital requirements through the facility provided by the company's bank. The company continues to operate within this facility and during the period the company agreed new facilities with its bank. The directors have considered future financial projections and future cashflow requirements and are confident that the company will continue in business for the foreseeable future.

Accordingly the directors consider it appropriate that the financial statements in respect of the period ended 30 December 2013 be prepared on a going concern basis.

1.3 Cash flow

The financial statements do not include a Cash Flow Statement because the company, as a small reporting entity, is exempt from the requirement to prepare such a statement under the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

1.4 Turnover

The turnover shown in the Profit and Loss Account represents the total amounts (exclusive of Value Added Tax) derived from rentals receivable on lettings to tenants, accrued on a time basis, by reference to the agreements entered.

1.5 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following bases:

1.6 Operating leases

Rentals under operating leases are charged to the Profit and Loss Account on a straight line basis over the lease term.

1.7 Deferred taxation

Full provision is made for deferred tax assets and liabilities arising from all timing differences between the recognition of gains and losses in the financial statements and recognition in the tax computation.

A net deferred tax asset is recognised only if it can be regarded as more likely than not that there will be suitable taxable profits from which the future reversal of the underlying timing differences can be deducted.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are calculated at the tax rates expected to be effective at the time the timing differences are expected to reverse.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are not discounted.

1.8 Financial instruments

Financial instruments are classified and accounted for, according to the substance of the contractual arrangement, as either financial assets, financial liabilities or equity instruments. An equity instrument is any contract that evidences a residual interest in the assets of the company after deducting all of its liabilities.

1.9 Capitalisation of interest

Interest costs in funding property under development are capitalised during the period of development. A property is regarded as being in the course of development until physical completion and the issue of the architect's Certificate of Practical Completion
