The Director and Trustees present their report and financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2009

PRINCIPAL OBJECT

The Charity's objects ("the Objects") are:

- i) To promote education, training and support to the children from the village called Ile-Ife in Nigeria ("beneficial area") to enable them to acquire and develop skills which may assist them to improve their conditions of life and well being in all respects.
- ii) To relieve need hardship or distress by: the provision of school fees for those students who find themselves in necessitous circumstances.

POLICIES

The main aim is to provide free Nursery and Primary education to the children at Ile Ife aged from 4years to 11 years who have no access to mainstream education.

The School was officially opened on the 21st Dec 2007.

20 six year old pupils started school on the 2nd January 2008 and another 20 are expected to start in September 2009 making a total of 60 children. The school has a Head teacher and 5 other teachers(inclusive of one to be employed in September 2009).

GENERAL POLICIES AND CONTRACTS

All policies, statements and contracts are reviewed on a continuous basis within the terms of the Project Development plan.

The policies and general management of the project are directed by the management committee.

Review of the Year.

The school progress reports of the children are very encouraging with a small proportion needing extra teaching support. The children started computer lessons in the year and also got their new Physical Education sports wear .

The toilets for both the teachers and the pupils were completed in 2009.

The children are taught 10 subjects which include Maths , English language, Health Education, Quantitative Reasoning , writing ,Yoruba , computer lessons , Literature and science .

We have had to hire 2 school buses to transport the children to and from school .

The new intake of children during the year were taken to a local zoo and Museum as their school trip, and they enjoyed the experience tremendously.

ETHOS AND DEVELOPMENT

We are looking to continue to raise funds for the following:

- The funding we are requesting will enable us to fund the Phase 2 of building costs i e (1) the computer room (2) Sick bay and (3) canteen
 - Acquire a Large bus for transportation to and from the school. Currently we hire 2 school buses which takes the children from and to school daily.

With the economy in credit crunch, we are finding it difficult to get individual sponsorship so we are looking to philanthropists and organizations for funding.

In addition we have started to develop the unused part of the School land to grow rice and corn as a means of supporting the school.

Conclusion

It has been very fulfilling to see the school come to reality and see the eagerness of the children to learn. They are respectful and polite. We will continue to raise funds so as to keep the school going. We look forward to the next intake of 20 children to start in September 2009.

1) Basis of Accounting.
