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Directors' report for the year ended 31 December 2014

The directors present their report and the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2014.

Principal activity

The principal activity of the company is that of nominating and presenting incumbents for vacant benefices in the Patronage Society's gift.

Transfer of patronage

During the past fifteen months the directors had been considering the important position of the company continuing to present incumbents to vacant benefices in the Patronage Society's gift, particularly in the light of current agenda being considered by General Synod regarding episcopacy and conscious of the knowledge that the company's own Memorandum and Articles of Association would need complete revision if the Patronage Society was to continue in its present form. Inevitably, the past historical position of the original founders of the Patronage Society in preserving classical evangelicalism was likely to be compromised.

Accordingly, it was resolved by the directors to approach Church Society and Church Pastoral Aid Society to enquire from them what models of patronage were available to the company and then, following responses from the parochial church councils of the benefices in the Patronage Society's gift, arrange for the patronage and rights of presentation to be transferred to which Society they most favoured.

A unanimous response was received from all the church councils in favour of Church Pastoral Aid Society and the Chairman communicated their decision accordingly.

On 15 January 2015, the Patronage Society was informed by the Provincial/Diocesan Registrar that all legal matters in connection with the transfer of patronage were now complete.

Arrangements will be commenced shortly to have the company struck off the company's register.
