This is the Joint Liquidators third annual report upon this matter. This report should be read in conjunction with the report of the initial meeting of creditors and subsequent annual reports.

1. RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS ACCOUNT

We attach an account of receipts and payments for the current period 9 July 2017 to 8 July 2018 and cumulatively from the commencement of the winding up to the end of the anniversary.

2. REALISATIONS

Assets

As previously reported, the assets of the Company being computers, furniture, fixtures and equipment, stock, and the goodwill were sold to 1128 Ltd for the sum of £5,285.00 plus VAT where applicable. The assets have been realised in full.

As detailed in the last annual report, the Joint Liquidators investigated the sale of the motor vehicle prior to the liquidation and it was concluded that it was sold at an undervalue. Due to this, it was agreed that the director, Mr Dudley Samuels, was to pay £1,500.00 into the liquidation in respect of the sale of the motor vehicle. This amount has been received in full with no further realisations to be made.

Other Assets

An amount of £654.68 has been received, being the cash at bank at the date of liquidation.

3. JOINT LIQUIDATORS' REMUNERATION

A Statement of Affairs fee of £5,000.00 was approved at the initial meeting of creditors held on 9 July 2015 which has been drawn by us, as Joint Liquidators. This is a fixed fee and was considered to be fair, reasonable and proportionate with the work carried out and agreed by creditors.

In the pre appointment period, category 2 disbursements of £149.62 were incurred and allocated to the case, of which an amount of £123.15 has been drawn, leaving unbilled disbursements of £26.47 during the post appointment period. The disbursements that have been incurred are detailed in Appendix II.

The Joint Liquidators' remuneration stated in the Receipts and Payments account is based on hourly costs at scale rates calculated on the time properly spent in the course of the liquidation and was approved at the initial meeting of creditors held on 9 July 2015.

In the current period the Joint Liquidators' have incurred time costs of £3,617.50 representing 18.35 hours at an average hourly charge-out rate of £197.14. Total time spent to date on this assignment amounts to 125.94 hours at an average composite rate of £186.26 per hour resulting in total time costs to date of £23,457.25. Joint Liquidators' fees of £915.00 plus VAT have been drawn to date leaving outstanding time costs of £22,542.25.

Please refer to Appendix I for a detailed breakdown of the work undertaken.

Administration & Planning – Administration and Planning relates to the cashiering functions required throughout the duration of the liquidation, which included the bank account reconciliations, the submission of annual Corporation Tax returns, and the maintaining of the estate account. It also includes the time allowed for case reviews to be undertaken, and the filing and maintaining of internal documents relating to the case. The time incurred to date amounts to 33.74 hours at a total cost of £5,569.75. These costs will increase during the course of the liquidation.

Creditors & Distribution – The time spent to date is 9.50 hours totalling £1,550.00 and relates to corresponding with creditors during the course of the liquidation. Further details can be found in section 4.

Investigations – The time spent to date on the Joint Liquidators investigations amounts to 50.25 hours, at a total cost of £9,963.75. This is detailed further in Section 5.

Floating Charge Assets – The time spent amounts to 20.40 hours at a total cost of £3,527.50. Further information can be found in Section 2. This category of time includes liaising with the director in respect of the funds due into the liquidation.

Employees – The time spent to date dealing with employee claims and queries is 1.80 hours totalling £542.50. Further details can be found in section 4.

Statutory & Compliance – Statutory & Compliance involves the preparation and circulation of the Joint Liquidators report to creditors upon appointment, preparing annual reports to creditors, filing the relevant documents to Companies House, including annual receipts and payments accounts, advertising throughout the liquidation in accordance with statutory requirements. The time spent to date amounts to 10.25 hours at a total cost of £2,303.75. Further time will be accrued until the liquidation is concluded.

Post Appointment category 2 disbursements of £224.26 have been allocated to the case from the commencement of the liquidation up to the anniversary which have not been drawn leaving unbilled disbursements of £224.26 together with pre appointment category 2 disbursements of £26.47. The disbursements that have been incurred are detailed in Appendix II.

Silke & Co Ltd chargeout rates and disbursements policy is attached at Appendix III.

All payments have been made in accordance with the rules and regulations generally as to the payment of costs and expenses in the liquidation, details of which can be found below:

Other Costs

The sum of £60.00 has been incurred and drawn, which relates to the insurance bond on the case, this is a statutory requirement under the guidelines produced by the Joint Liquidators regulatory body, this amount has been drawn in full.

The sum of £150.00 has been incurred by RGH Associates in respect of the professional valuation of the assets pre liquidation. This has been drawn in full.



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The sum of £220.00 has been incurred and drawn in respect of legal fees relating to dismissal of the Winding Up Petition presented against the Company pre appointment.

Also listed is statutory advertising in the sum of £201.00, which was required on the case both pre and post appointment, which has been drawn.

The sum of £75.79 has been incurred and drawn, in respect of room hire. It was necessary to hold members and creditors meetings in order to place the Company into liquidation, and in order to make the meetings accessible to all creditors.

The sum of £1.00 has been incurred and paid by Silke & Co, this relates to searches that were carried out pre appointment in order to comply with Anti Money Laundering Regulations.

The sum of £5.00 has been paid to DVLA Swansea, which relates to searches that were carried out post appointment during the investigations into the motor vehicles sold pre appointment.

Also listed is mail redirection in the sum of £160.00, which has been incurred and drawn. This was needed for creditor correspondence to be redirected to us from the trading address of the Company.

A comparison between the estimated figures and actual figures for expenses is provided at Appendix II.

A Creditors' Guide to Liquidators' Fees can be found on the portal or on our website, which includes creditors' rights to further information and to challenge.

4. CREDITORS' CLAIMS AND DIVIDEND PROSPECTS

Employee Claims

Two employees were made redundant on 9 July 2015. The relevant information for employees to submit claims has been made to the Redundancy Payments Office and information and help was given to employees to enable them to submit their claims online.

Preferential claims have been received amounting to £399.98; the director's Statement of Affairs estimated no preferential claims to be made.

I would advise creditors that after taking into account the expenses of the liquidation there are currently insufficient funds available to pay a dividend to preferential creditors.

Unsecured Creditors

Ordinary unsecured claims have been received amounting to £40,751.04, the director's Statement of Affairs estimated unsecured claims of £74,586.55. Please be advised that claims may still be received and therefore the total value of unsecured claims is not known as present.

At this stage although creditors' claims have been lodged we have not taken steps to formally agree the claims of unsecured creditors as it appears unlikely there will be a dividend payable to unsecured creditors until and unless further assets are realised.

5. OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

Investigation

As previously reported, the Joint Liquidators have concluded their investigations.



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6. EC REGULATIONS (WHETHER PROCEEDINGS ARE MAIN PROCEEDINGS OR TERRITORIAL)

The Company's centre of main interest was in the UK and therefore it is considered that the EC Regulations will apply. These proceedings are main proceedings as defined in Article 3 of the EC Regulation.

7. CREDITORS' RIGHTS

Any unsecured creditors may, with the permission of the court or with the concurrence of 5% in value of the unsecured creditors (including the creditor in question) request further details of the Joint Liquidator's remuneration and expenses, within 21 days of receipt of this report. Any secured creditor may request the same details in the same time limit.

An unsecured creditor may, with the permission of the court or with the concurrence of 10% in value of the creditors (including the creditor in question), apply to court to challenge the amount and/or basis of the Joint Liquidator's fees and the amount of any proposed expenses or expenses already incurred, within 8 weeks of receipt of this report. Any secured creditor may make a similar application to court within the same time limit.

If there are any matters which you consider we should be aware of regarding the way in which the Company's business has been conducted, and on any potential recoveries for the estate, we shall be pleased to hear from you. This request for information is standard practice and does not imply any criticism or cause of action against any person concerned in the management of the Company's affairs.

8. CONCLUSION

As detailed above, there are no outstanding matters and a final report will be issued to all creditors in due course.
