- 5.2 My time costs for the period from 12 January 2018 are £2,038. This represents 12.5 hours at an average rate of £163 per hour.

Additional Information in Relation to the Liquidators' Fees, Expenses & Disbursements

1 Staff Allocation and the Use of Sub-Contractors
