#### Company activities and impact

A Touch of Gentleness, a non profit CIC, was set up on 2022 to bring more joy and connection, through gentleness and touch, back to the heart of communities. To do this we train volunteers to give a beautiful hand massage whilst listening with gentle presence. This service is then offered to various organisations, charities, events and gatherings within their local community. We did the first training in April 2022 and during the financial year 2022-2003, we have run 10 training days. As a reult of these training days we currently have volunteers regularly offering this service in various local organisations and settings including; a cafe for Ukranians, the staff and clients of ESRA East Sussex Recovery Alliance, a wellbeing hub, the voluntary staff teaching English to foreign speaking citizens, a church coffee morning, Age Concern, another couple of care homes and each month we offer a day at The Gather Space in the Beacon shopping centre where we are always busy and gratefully received. As well as the regular commitments we have also offered our services at other meetings such as Holding Space coffee mornings, Association of Carers, Warm hubs and events such as Tenants first conference. Inhouse trainings have been run for the staff and volunteers at Olive Tree Cancer Support, Peabody Housing Trust, and in June we have been asked to do an inhouse training at the Conquest Hospital. Both the volunteers that give the massage and those that receive the massage equally experience the physical and emotional benefits that gentle touch and human connection brings. Over this last year we have offered over 1150 hand massages with gentleness.
