The company runs The Rainbow Community Café in Woodley, Berkshire on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays between 10.30 am and 1.30 pm and reopened in June 2021 after its Covid-induced closure. Its ethos is to provide healthy, home-cooked food at reasonable prices. During the last year the Café has benefitted the local community in the following ways:

- a) Local residents of all ages, including students from the local Special School, have had a welcoming place to meet and enjoy a meal, snack, or refreshing drink.
- b) Local residents who are alone or lonely can find someone to talk with.
- c) Training was resumed for work experience students from a Special School and for older people through Social Services, having been suspended during the Covid closure.
- d) The Café has an arrangement with the local police station in providing a venue where residents can meet police officers to discuss matters of concern, if they wish.
- e) The Café acts as collection point for Woodley residents donating goods to local welfare charities
