MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

of





THE WOODFINES (EMERSON PARK)
MAINTENANCE LIMITED

- 1. The name of the Company is "THE WOODFINES (EMERSON PARK) MAINTENANCE LIMITED".
- 2. The registered office of the Company will be situate in England.
- 3. The objects for which the Company is established are:-
  - (A) (i) To take a lease of The Woodfines, Emerson Park, Hornchurch in the London Borough of Havering (with the exception of those parts being flats which are to be leased to individual tenants) from D. L. and P. Luck Limited for a term of 99 years from the 24th day of June 1978 at a ground rent of £1 per annum.
  - (ii) To join with the lessees to maintain The Woodfines including the roofs, foundations, main walls, main timber floors, drains, sewers, gutters, pipes, wires, roads, footpaths, ways, boundary walls, fences, gardens, lawns, landings, common staircases, passages and access ways the common television aerials and all other parts thereof in good and substantial repair order and condition and where necessary properly painted.
  - (iii) To ensure so far as possible the carrying out and due performance by all members of the Company of the covenants and conditions contained in the respective leases of any part or parts of The Woodfines aforesaid.
  - (B) To carry on any other trade or business whatsoever which can, in the opinion of the Board of Directors, be advantageously carried on by the Company in connection with or as ancillary to any of the above businesses or the general business of the Company, or further any of its objects.

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- (C) To borrow or raise or secure the payment of money for the purposes of or in connection with the Company's business, and for the purposes of or in connection with the borrowing or raising of money by the Company to become a member of any building society.
- (D) To draw, make, accept, endorse, negotiate, discount and execute promissory notes, bills of exchange and other negotiable instruments.
- (E) To invest and deal with the moneys of the Company not immediately required for the purposes of its business in or upon such investments or securities and in such manner as may from time to time be determined.
- (F) To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the above objects or any of them.
- 4. The liability of the members is limited.
- 5. The share capital of the Company is £100, livided into 100 shares of £1 each.

WE, the several persons whose names and addresses are subscribed, are desirous of being formed into a Company in pursuance of this Memorandum of Association, and we respectively agree to take the number of shares in the capital of the Company set opposite our respective names.

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

of

THE WOODFINES (EMERSON PARK)
MAINTENANCE LIMITED

- 1. Subject as hereinafter provided, the regulations contained in Parts I and II of Table A in the Fist Schedule to the Companies Act 1948 (hereinafter referred to as "Table A") shall apply to the Company.
- 2. Regulations 24, 53, 75, 77 and 88 of Part I of Table A aforesaid (hereinafter referred to as "Part I of Table A") and regulation 5 of Part II of Table A shall not apply to the Company, but the Articles hereinafter contained together with the remaining regulations of Part I of Table A and regulations 2, 3, 4 and 6 of Part II of Table A, subject to the modifications hereinafter expressed, shall constitute the regulations of the Company.
- 3. The shares shall be at the disposal of the Directors, who may allot, grant options over or otherwise dispose of them to such persons at such times and on such conditions as they think proper, subject to the provisions of the next following Article and to regulation 2 of Tart II of Table A, and provided that no shares shall be issued at a discount, except as provided by section 57 of the Act, and provided also that the Directors shall decline to register as a shareholder any persons who shall not be a lessee either alone or jointly with any other lessees of the maisonettes/flats and car parking spaces in Menthone Place Horchurch in the London Borough of Havering but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing.
- 4. The Company in General Meeting may direct that any original shares for the time being unissued and any new shares from time to time to be created shall, before they are issued, be offered to the members or to any class of members. If any such direction is given, such offer shall be made by notice specifying the . number of shares offered, and limiting a time within which the offer, if not accepted, will be deemed to be declined, and after the expiration of such time, or on the receipt of an intimation from the person to whom the offer is made that he declines to accept the share offered, the Directors may, subject to these Articles, dispose of the same in such manner as they think most beneficial to the Company, and the Directors may, in like manner,

dispose of any such new or original shares as aforesaid, which, by reason of the proportion borne by them to the number of persons entitled to any such offer as aforesaid or by reason of any other difficulty in apportioning the same, cannot in the opinion of the Directors be conveniently offered in manner hereinbefore provided.

- 5. In regulation 11 of table A, Part I, the words "(not being a fully paid share)" and the words "(other than fully paid shares)" shall be omitted.
- 6. The proviso to regulation 32 of Part I of Table A shall be omitted.
- 7. Unless and until otherwise determined by the Company in General Meeting, the number of Directors shall not be less than two nor more than five. The following shall be the first Directors of the Company, that is to say- Cedric Lionel Mullis and Peter Scott Kendal.
- 8. Other shareholders in the Company shall serve as a Director of the Company for a period of at least two years. The Directors shall be appointed in alphabetical order. In the event of any shareholder not wishing to serve as a Director he or she may appoint another shareholder in his or her place or alternatively any other person who is acceptable to the majority of the existing Directors.
- 9. The proviso to regulation 79 of Part I of Table A shall be omitted.
- 10. The Company shall not be subject to section 185 of the Act, and accordingly any person may be appointed or elected as a Director, whatever his age, and no Director shall be required to vacate his office of Director by reason of his attaining or having attained the age of seventy years or any other age.
- 11. The office of a Director shall be vacated-
  - (1) If by notice in writing to the Company he resigns the office of Director.
  - (2) If he ceases to be a Director by virtue of section 182 of the Act.
  - (3) If he becomes bankrupt or insolvent, or enters into any arrangement with his creditors.
  - (4) If he becomes of unsound mind.
  - (5) If he is prohibited from being a Director by any order made under section 188 of the Act.
  - (6) If he is removed from office by a resolution duly passed under section 184 of the Act.

12. The first Secretary of the Company shall be Howard Thomas.
