NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2015

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1.1 Basis of preparation of financial statements

The full financial statements, from which these abbreviated accounts have been extracted, have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015).

1.2 Going concern

The company made a loss for the year and at the balance sheet date had net current liabilities and net liabilities. The ultimate parent company has confirmed that it has the ability and will support the company financially so that the company will be able to meet its financial obligations as and when they fall due. On this basis the directors have prepared the accounts on a going concern basis.

1.3 Turnover

Turnover represents amounts receivable by the company in respect of software and IT consultancy services supplied during the year exclusive of Value Added Tax.

Set-up fees are recognised at the earlier of the system going live or six months from the date of contract.

Subscription fees are recognised evenly over the period of the contract.

Consultancy fees are recognised in the period in which the service is provided.

1.4 Deferred taxation

Full provision is made for deferred tax assets and liabilities arising from all timing differences between the recognition of gains and losses in the financial statements and recognition in the tax computation.

A net deferred tax asset is recognised only if it can be regarded as more likely than not that there will be suitable taxable profits from which the future reversal of the underlying timing differences can be deducted.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are calculated at the tax rates expected to be effective at the time the timing differences are expected to reverse.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are not discounted.

1.5 Foreign currencies

Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at rates of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date.

Transactions in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rate ruling on the date of the transaction.

Exchange gains and losses are recognised in the Profit and Loss Account.
