

#### NOTES ON THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS

#### 1. Accounting policies

- i) The accounts are prepared in accordance with the special provisions of Part VII of the Companies Act 1985 relating to small companies and with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective March 2000).
- ii) The accounts are prepared on the historical cost basis of accounting.
- iii) Depreciation is calculated at rates estimated to write off the cost of the assets over their useful lives.

#### 3. Creditors
