1 Introduction

- 1.1 I, Andrew Dix ("the Liquidator") of LB Insolvency Solutions Limited ("LBIS") Swift House, Ground Floor, 18 Hoffmanns Way, Chelmsford, Essex, CM1 1GU, was appointed as Liquidator of 21 OC Ltd ("the Company") on 12 December 2019. The affairs of the Company are now fully wound up and this is my final account of the liquidation, which covers the period since my last progress report ("the Period").
- 1.2 Information about the way that we will use, and store personal data on insolvency appointments, can be found at www.lbinsolvency.co.uk/privacy-policy. If you are unable to download this, please contact us and a hard copy will be provided to you.
- 1.3 The trading address of the Company was 70 Baker Street, London, W1U 7DJ.
- 1.4 The registered office of the Company was changed to c/o LB Insolvency Solutions Limited, Swift House, Ground Floor, 18 Hoffmanns Way, Chelmsford, Essex, CM1 1GU and its registered number is 10621022.

2 Receipts and Payments

2.1 At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the Period with a comparison to the directors' Declaration of Solvency ("DOS") incorporating a cumulative account since my appointment, which provides details of the remuneration charged and expenses incurred and paid by the Liquidator.

Receipts

2.2 Tax refund of £68.68 was received from HMRC in respect of a pre-liquidation period.

Payments

Office Holder Expenses

2.3 £35.55 has been paid to LBIS in respect of disbursements incurred in the Period, details of which are at section 5 below.

Corporation Tax

2.4 £15.58 has been paid to HMRC in respect of tax due on interest received in the Period.

VAT Irrecoverable

2.5 As the Company was not VAT registered it has not been possible to reclaim the final amount of £13.17.

Storage Costs

2.6 £30.30 has been paid to RH Data Storage Limited to store the liquidation files from closure for a period of 6 years.

Ordinary Shareholders

2.7 A total amount of £19,178.42 has been distributed to the Shareholders, details of which are set out in section 5 below.

3 Work undertaken by the Liquidator

- 3.1 This section of the report provides creditors with an overview of the work undertaken in the liquidation since 12 December 2019, together with information on the overall outcome of the liquidation.
- The Directors held a Board Meeting and approved the DOS which was prepared with the assistance of the proposed Liquidator who was subsequently appointed at a general meeting held on 12 December 2019. The basis of the Liquidator's remuneration was approved and agreed as a set fee.
- 3.3 After realising the Company's cash at bank and making the necessary statutory filing, the Liquidator ensured that the claim of HMRC was paid and all returns were up to date. Any queries were investigated and, subsequently, full tax clearance was provided.

Unrealisable Assets

3.4 There were no unrealised assets.

4 Outcome for Creditors

Unsecured Creditors

4.1 It transpired that, following a review of the Company information, profits due to three members, Mr R Bazzi, Ms V De Froberville and PVG Design had not been paid by the Company. On 29 January 2020 letters were issued to those members notifying them of the unpaid profits requesting that a completed Proof of Debt form be provided confirming their claim in the liquidation. All claims were received, together with a signed resolution waiving statutory interest, and on 10 February 2020 the following payments were made to those members:

5 Distributions to Members

- 5.1 The following final cash distributions to members have been made:
 - £19,178.42 at 1.92 pence in the pound on 10 February 2021
- 5.2 In addition, the following first and interim distribution in specie was made to the shareholders:
 - £1,726,649.00 at 172.6649 pence in the pound on 4 December 2020 in respect of the Directors loan accounts.

6 Liquidator's Remuneration

- 6.1 As mentioned in the annual report, the Liquidator had not sought a resolution from the members to agree his remuneration since his appointment.
- 6.2 However, for the purposes of reporting to the members and creditors I can advise that the Liquidator's time costs for the period from 12 December 2020 to 7 April 2021 are £8,290.00. This represents 37 hours at an average rate of £224.05 per hour. Attached as Appendix B is a Time Analysis which provides details of the activity costs incurred by staff grade during this period in respect of the costs fixed by reference to time properly spent by the Liquidator in managing the liquidation. The Liquidator would confirm that £3,000.00 plus VAT and disbursements of £1,791.00 has been drawn and that no further fees will be taken.
- Also, attached as Appendix C is a cumulative Time Analysis for the period from 12 December 2019 to 7 April 2021 which provides details of my total time costs since the date of my appointment.
- 6.4 Attached as Appendix D is additional information in relation to this firm's policy on staffing, the use of subcontractors, disbursements and details of our current charge-out rates by staff grade.
