STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT (cont)

Interest in MCCP Ltd directorship is welcomed at any time, however an active recruitment programme is implemented preceding the Annual General Meeting in a variety of media. This may include verbal discussions, notices placed locally, press releases, newsletters to members and/or via our database of local organisations across Bro Ddyfi. Applications are invited from all members of the community with an interest in enabling MCCP Ltd to achieve its aims and objectives. In line with our Equal Opportunities Policy we appoint Directors via a fair and transparent process regardless of age, gender, social background, ability/disability, culture, ethnic origin or religious belief.* Expressions of interest in directorship are received by the Management Committee for consideration and are democratically elected on the basis of suitability to undertake the required responsibilities. All Directors receive an induction handbook containing latest accounts, copies of minutes, governing document, Charity Commission publications detailing legal responsibilities and other relevant information.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

These are stated in the Memorandum of Association to advance the education of children up to the age of twelve years in Machynlleth and surrounding area by promoting facilities for daily care, recreation and education of such children, and by promoting good standards of child care by the parents of such children and all persons and organisations providing such facilities

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

During 2006/2007 MCCP Ltd continued to implement and consolidate the changes agreed at the end of the last financial year. The new payment policy, which became effective from September, has almost eliminated outstanding debts and has led to a much more stable financial situation. The Welsh Language continues to be a firm commitment and the 'Cylch Meithrin Y Plas' has been expanded. In March bilingual Employee handbooks were completed and distributed.

MCCP Ltd enjoyed some funding successes during the year In September MCCP purchased uniforms which were funded through a grant, which has helped create a cohesive corporate identity. Other 2007 success include £428 for inclusive play activities. Open access play funding £170 for Seedy Sunday workshop redecoration of the Nursery.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE (cont)

Demographic fluctuations have led to accommodation changes at the Nursery and lower numbers at the Club, the later causes MCCP Ltd some financial concerns. On a more positive note there is a waiting list for the under two's at the Nursery. August 2007 saw an excellent Estyn report. All this has led to need for a different staffing structure at the management team level that will be implemented in September 2007.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The Statement of Financial Activities is shown on page 6 to the Accounts, and shows income of £203,363 and expenditure of £197,687, resulting in net incoming resources of £5,676 as analysed between the various funds detailed therein

All the assets as shown in the Balance Sheet are held for the purpose of the company's charitable objectives Full details of capital expenditure are shown in note 8 to the accounts

MCCP Ltd aim to have a reserve of 3 months trading monies and are working well towards this

DIRECTORS' RESPONSIBILITIES

Company law requires the directors to prepare financial statements for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the state of the company and of the surplus/deficit of the company for that period.
