Feed Avalon CIC is a social enterprise that establishes food systems that are socially and economically empowering in order to optimise food resilience in Glastonbury, Street and the surrounding areas.

Autumn 2021, after we eased out of crisis mode we organised courses in the Community Garden. This was with help of Somerset Community Foundation who teamed up with Somerset Community Food to provide the Growing Grant. We held 8 workshops 4 cooking and 4 herbal medicine with ourselves teaching and invited guest tutors. They were such a success. People were so happy to be together in the community again in the safe environment of the garden; learning new skills and reconnecting friendships.

In spring of 2022, with thanks to Smart Communities Food Resilience Grant Scheme, we held workshops in the community garden aimed at families and adults. They were a great success with folk leaving courses with knowledge, inspiration and plants to grow.

We continued to grow plants in the nursery of the Red Brick Community Garden for people in the area to purchase at a vary nominal price. Taking them to local events such as Scythe Fair to reach a wider audience.

We held the annual Seed Swap, collaborating with other local groups/ farms/ growers. Providing free seeds for the community.
