1 Accounting policies

Basis of preparation

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the Technical release 03/11 Residential Service Charge Accounts published jointly by the professional accountancy bodies, ARMA and RICS.

Following the advice in this technical release, service charge monies that are received from the residents of The Arc are held on trust for the residents and the relating expenditure on maintenance of the common parts, in accordance with the lease, are shown in separate service charge accounts for the property that do not form part of annual accounts of the company.

2 Corporation tax

There is no corporation tax payable based on the result for the year (2013 - no corporation tax payable).

3 Share capital

The company has no share capital, being limited by guarantee. Every member undertakes to contribute such amount as may be required (not exceeding £1) to the company's assets if it should be wound up while they are a member or within one year after they cease to be a member, for payment of the company's debts and liabilities contracted before they cease to be a member, and of the costs, charges and expenses of winding up, and for the adjustments of the rights of the contributories amoung themselves.
