ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

OF

BALDERNOCK PROPERTIES LIMITED ("the Company")

1. In these articles:

"Model Articles" means the articles contained in Schedule 1 to the Companies (Model Articles) Regulations 2008.

A reference in these articles to a "regulation" is a reference to the regulation of that number in the Model Articles.

2. The regulations contained in the Model Articles, apart from regulations 21, 26(5) and 11(2) apply to the company except insofar as they are inconsistent with these articles.

Decisions of Directors

- 3. All acts done by a meeting of directors, or a committee of directors or by any director shall, even if it is discovered afterwards that:
- (a) there was a defect in the appointment of any director;
- (b) any director had been disqualified from holding office;
- (c) any director had vacated office or was not entitled to vote

be valid as if every such person had been duly appointed and was qualified and had continued to be a director and had been entitled to vote.

Records of Decisions to be Kept

4. The directors must ensure that the Company keeps a record, in writing, for at least 10 years from the date of the decision recorded, of every unanimous or majority decision taken by the directors. Where decisions of directors are taken by electronic means, such decisions must be recorded by the directors in permanent form so that they may be read by the naked eye.

Methods of Appointing Directors

5. If as a result of death or bankruptcy, the Company has no shareholders and no directors, the transmittee of the last shareholder to have died or had a bankruptcy order made against him has the right by notice in writing to appoint any natural person who is willing to act and is permitted to do so, to be a director.

Termination of Director's Appointment

6. The following shall be added at the end of regulation 18:

"he has, for more than six consecutive months been absent without the permission of the other directors from meetings of directors held during that period and the other directors resolve that

he has ceased to be a director."

Directors' Power to Allot Shares

- 7. The directors may offer or allot shares, grant rights to subscribe for or to convert any security into or otherwise deal in, or dispose of shares on such terms and at such time as they may decide provided that:
 - (a) the maximum amount of shares in respect of which the directors are so authorised is £1,000;
 - (b) this authority may only be exercised for a period of five years commencing on the date of incorporation of the Company provided that the directors may, before such expiry make one or more offers or agreements which would or might require shares to be allotted after such expiry and the directors may allot shares after such authority has expired in pursuance of every such offer or agreement as if the power conferred by these articles had not expired; and
 - (c) this authority shall only apply insofar as the Company has not renewed, waived or revoked it by ordinary resolution or by a written resolution in accordance with section 282(2) of the Companies Act 2006.

Share Transfers

- 8. Save as expressly permitted by the Model Articles, a shareholder must not enter into any arrangement where the terms upon which that shareholder holds any shares are to be varied if as a result any interest in those shares is varied, disposed of or created or extinguished.
- 9. Notwithstanding any other provision of the Model Articles, the directors must not register a transfer of any share or any interest in any share to any minor, undischarged bankrupt, trustee in bankruptcy or person of unsound mind.

Transmission of Shares

10. The following shall be added between the words "person" and "and" in the second line of Regulation 27(2)(a):

"and if no choice is made by the transmittee, he shall be deemed to have elected to become the holder of those shares:"

Proceedings at general meetings

- 11. (a) If and so long as there is only one member of the Company, a decision is taken by the member, which may be taken in general meeting, is as effective as if agreed by the Company in general meeting.
 - (b) A decision taken by a sole member under paragraph (a) (unless taken by way of a written resolution) shall be recorded in writing and a copy shall be provided to the Company.

Number of Directors

- 12. The minimum number of directors is one and, unless otherwise determined by ordinary resolution the number of directors is not subject to a maximum. A sole director may exercise all the powers and discretions given to the directors by these articles.
- 13. The quorum for directors' meetings is one.

Disqualification and Removal of Directors

14. Regulation 18 is amended:

by replacing "by notice to the company" in paragraph (f) with "by notice delivered to the office or tendered at a meeting of the directors"

Proceedings of Directors

15. The quorum for the transaction of the business of the directors is two except when there is only one director. When there is only one director, he may exercise all the powers conferred on directors by these articles.

Indemnity

16. Regulation 52 is amended:

by adding after "may be indemnified out of the company's assets" in the first line the words "otherwise than as a result of his own negligence or default";
